SPIRITUAL TOOLS FOR TEEN GIRLS

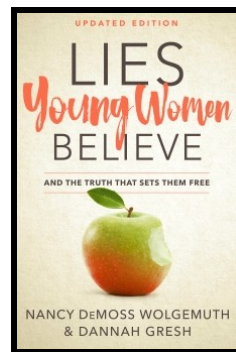

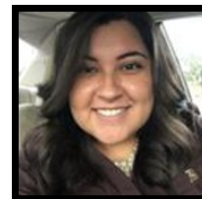

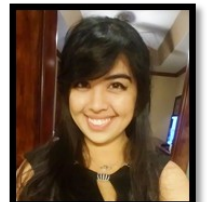
